

Depuis 25 ans, la démarche de l'atelier Barrois fait le pari de la vigueur hybride et du travail transversal en tissant des liens étroits entre les métiers d'art, l'architecture, l'ingénierie, l'art et le design. 



For 25 years, the glass studio's approach has been one of commitment to hybrid vigour and cross-cutting work, creating close links between fine crafts, architecture, engineering, art and design. It is about innovating, experimenting, questioning the material on a case by case basis. Through working by hand, glass – worked while cold, worked while hot, engraved, curved, cast, thermoformed, moulded, layered, gilded, enamelled or textured inside the workshop – reveals new aesthetic and technical, functional or poetic fields of application.

This work is based on the certainty that balance, refinement, functionality and demanding standards will always be the qualities of layout and interior design.

Beyond that – as in the past, as always – the mystery, beauty and poetry of the material will bring that extra touch of soul which we all seek.






